Adult females give birth in dens to baby bears called cubs Cubs are born in January and they weigh about 8 ounces at birth They are born blind, covered with fine hair and they nurse on their mother's milk Female bears may give birth to 1 to 6 cubs at a time, but 3 is the average litter size in New Jersey Cubs grow very quickly and they weigh
